The judges prefer that prosecutors and defense attorneys in criminal cases at the court review the presentence report before the starting time of the sentencing hearing. Those reports are usually available in the judges' offices several days before the sentencing hearing, and attorneys are always welcome to review the reports there in the days before those hearings.
