DELAWARE COUNTY COURTHOUSE UPDATE:
JUNE 2020

On March 20, 2020, in-person access to the Delaware County courthouse was limited to emergencies and time-sensitive matters due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Effective June 1, 2020, in-person entry by the public to the Delaware County courthouse at 117 N. Union Street in Delaware is no longer restricted.

We understand that some persons remain hesitant about returning to the courthouse. The General Division, Domestic Relations Division, Clerk of Courts, and Public Defender's office all continue to offer electronic options for communicating with us, for filing court documents, and for participating in our hearings.

We have taken steps to accommodate the health and safety concerns of all courthouse visitors. The courthouse is being cleaned and disinfected multiple times every day. Hand sanitizer is readily available at the courthouse entrance, in the public hallway on the third floor, and elsewhere in the building.

Visitors to the courthouse are welcome to bring and to wear a mask or other face covering. If you do not have a mask, you can request one from the building-security staff at the first-floor entrance or from any court staff member. Court staff members will be wearing masks or other face coverings when they interact with attorneys, parties, and jurors.

The General Division is now welcoming parties, attorneys, witnesses, and visitors for in-person hearings at the courthouse while continuing to offer anyone the option to participate in our hearings through the Zoom videoconference platform. The Domestic Relations Division will notify parties and counsel regarding in-person appearances. Zoom videoconferences will continue to be utilized for most court hearings. Ongoing updates will be posted as circumstances change.

The Clerk's office is open for in-person document filings. Documents can also be filed with the Clerk through the court's e-filing system, or they can be sent to the Clerk by fax, by U.S. mail, or by private mail carrier. In addition, a drop box is available on the first floor of the courthouse, and

documents can be deposited there for filing in the Clerk's office. Persons who deposit any documents in that box should immediately call the Clerk's office at 740-833-2500 to alert the Clerk's staff about those documents.
