

3/13/20 Email to Delaware County Bar Association from Domestic Relations Court:

While we continue to deal with the every-changing COVID-19 landscape. I wanted to address a possible issue regarding parenting time orders. As you all know, Governor DeWine has closed all Ohio schools as of March 17, 2020 for an “extended spring break” period of three weeks. In an effort to deescalate any situations or confusion that may arise regarding this public health mandate, please inform your clients that this extended spring break DOES NOT extend the spring break period set forth in their parenting time orders. Only the originally scheduled spring break period in the child’s school district shall be considered spring break for parenting time orders (unless otherwise specified in the order). All other time periods affected by the closing of school buildings shall be treated as a normal school day pursuant to the parties’ parenting time schedule.
